## England Golf Junior Champion Club (JCC)

### Qualifying Round - Rules and Conditions of Play

1. The competition shall be called the England Golf Junior Champion Club and the winning team will go forward to represent Cornwall in the national final the year's competition. The venue for the competition shall be decided annually by the Cornwall Golf Union. Entries for this competition should be sent to the County Secretary together with the entry fee of £30 (One team entry only per club).
2. The qualification for players representing clubs shall be:
  - a) Must be of amateur status as defined by the R & A Rules Limited.
  - b) Confined to junior members of the club under the age of 18 years at 00:00hrs on 1<sup>st</sup> January if the competition year.
3. No player can play in one season for more than one club in any competition organised by the Union. A season extends from the 1<sup>st</sup> April in one year to 31<sup>st</sup> March in the following year. For clarity the English Junior Champion Club Qualifier, the George Bolitho League, The Kernow Cup and the Brian Gripe Junior Summer Knockout competitions are deemed to be events commencing after 1<sup>st</sup> April.
4. The competition is open to boys and girls. The maximum handicap index for boys is 28.0, and for girls is 36.0. Boys to play off Men's white tees and girls to play off Ladies red tees.
  - Boys - 95% of Course Handicap from white tees.
  - Girls - 95% of Course Handicap from red tees plus adjustment below
  - Adjustment = (Ladies' Course Rating – Men's Course Rating) – (Ladies' Par – Men's Par)
  - The CGU recommends using the Mixed Tee Handicap Calculator available from <https://www.conqu.co.uk/wp-content/uploads/WHSDocs/Mixed-Tee-Calculator-WHS.xlsx>
5. The event comprises teams of three players representing their club playing individual stableford off handicap over eighteen holes. The winners will be the team with the highest total aggregate stableford points score from all 3 cards. In the event of a tie the winners shall be decided on the last 9, 6 or 3-hole total of the three cards.
